Dear Pastors, Partners and Fellow Beloved,

And let us not be weary in well doing: for in due season we shall reap, if we faint not. Galatians 6:9
Praise God your prayers and support are paying off again. On January 22 a resident of Gardenia care home, Pauline, asked Jesus to save her. Pauline loves Dayton and Dayton always takes time to walk around and talk to Pauline. As they were walking Dayton told Pauline she was going to heaven and wanted her to go to. Pauline said she wanted to go but didn't understand how, so Dayton called Cher over to talk to her. While this was happening I was having a very intense conversation with the manager of Gardenia, Jill, about the Bible and end times. Jill just was asking all kinds of questions, which was very exciting since normally she seemed to avoid us when we come to the care home. In the end Jill said "I believe, but I'm not quite there yet". Just as Jill said this Dayton came and got me and said please come talk to Pauline. When I got there Pauline ("trembling and astonished" Acts 9:6) had tears in her eyes and was shaking and saying "I just don't know how to do it". We held her hands and continued to tell her it was simple, and led her in prayer. She was so relieved and excited and said "I want my family to know this!" Praise the LORD!!! Please keep Pauline and Jill in your prayers as we were going to take them some literature and Bibles but the very next day Guernsey went into a "hard lockdown". It is heartbreaking to us not being able to have our weekly service with the residents. We are sending cards and gifts often though, and can't wait to see them again.

So we've been in "hard lockdown" since January 23, meaning we are only allowed out for two hours a day for exercise and to get essentials. Travel to from the island is only allowed for essential workers and compassionate cases. Thankfully we have just been told today, March 3, that the restrictions will begin to ease on March 8.

Walter Le Page, the elderly gentlemen that comes for Sunday lunch and sometimes for church, has been in the hospital for two weeks now with injuries from falling and an ulcer that ruptured. Please remember him in your prayers. He loves the Lord and is the only person in Guernsey that we know willing to hand out Gospel tracts.

Because Guernsey has fared so much better than the UK and Europe concerning COVID 19, the housing and rental market pricing has skyrocketed making our prospects of finding a building for the ministry look very dim. We do know though, that nothing is impossible with our God. Please help us continue to pray He will provide a place for us.

I was able to speak with Jerry Bermon yesterday while on a walk. Unfortunately he is not ready to change "his religion". I'm thankful though God is keeping that door open.

Dillon and Dayton are growing like weeds and working hard in homeschool. They could use some prayers though as they are finding it really difficult not having any friends. Please pray God will supply some. Cher is doing a lot better. Her shoulder is still locked but the pain is very minimal and she has about 60% mobility now which allows her to play the piano again, praise the Lord!

Edward Thal's surgery and treatment went really well, his doctor was very pleased. Please pray he and Dana can join us as soon as the travel restrictions are cleared.
